

# **VIRGINIA ROSE**

Rosa virginiana

Fast-growing vibrant pink rose bush with lustrous dark green leaves. The fruit is high in Vitamin C and can be used to make jam or tea.

#### **Benefits for Wildlife**

- Attracts bees, butterflies, and predatory insects
- Rose hips last through winter, providing a food source for overwintering birds and mammals
- Dense, thorny branches make for ideal nesting habitat

Host to 124 caterpillar species, including: (common names) Apple Sphinx; White-Lined Sphinx; Crocus Geometer; Pale Beauty; Blinded Sphinx; Imperial Moth
