

BLACK CHOKEBERRY

Aronia melanocarpa

Beautiful, hardy, and beneficial medium-sized shrub, well suited for use in developed landscapes. Produces lovely flowers and edible fruit, and is forage for many wildlife species.

Benefits for Wildlife

- Pollinators are attracted to the springtime flowers
- Fruit eaten by numerous songbird species
- Deer browse the foliage and branches

Benefits for People

- Beautiful white flowers in spring, dark fruit and brilliant red leaves in fall
- Edible fruit is used in jellies, wine, health drinks, and more
- Cultivated as a cash crop in Europe
