CUTLEAF/GREEN-HEADED CONEFLOWER

Rudbeckia laciniata

Yellow, daisy-like flowers with drooping rays, and a yellow/green center cone.

Growing Information

Sunlight Full sun, part shade
Soil Type Moist, slightly acidic
Height 3-6'
Flowering calendar July-September
