

FLAX-LEAVED STIFF-ASTER

Ionactis linarifolia

A lesser known member of the Aster family, *lonactis linarifolia* is a unique, low growing perennial with violet petals. It prefers acidic soils low in nutrients, and is great for drought tolerant landscapes.
