

PLANTAIN-LEAVED PUSSYTOES

Antennaria plantaginifolia

Named for its cat paw-like flower heads, this low-growing perennial makes an excellent ground cover in the right conditions. Leaves are wooly and silvery-green and the flowers range from white (male) to light pink (female).
